The Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS), the National Institute of Health in Italy, is the leading technical and scientific body of the National Health Service.

The ISS researchers publish about 1600 articles per year in national and international journals and books. The digital archive DSpace ISS (http://dspace.iss.it) contains all publications by ISS researchers.

The main publications edited by the ISS Publishing Unit are a quarterly journal (Annali), a monthly newsletter (Notiziario), some technical reports series.

Annali publishes articles in English whereas all other publications are in Italian or English.

## Annali dell'Istituto Superiore di Sanità

Quarterly science journal publishing original articles, reviews, monographs, technical and brief notes in the field of public health. It is peer-reviewed and indexed in the main bibliographic databases. Articles published as from 2001 are online at www.iss.it/anna Since 2004 the full-text is also freely available in PubMed (www.pubmed.gov).

Instructions to authors are printed in each issue and are available online.



Monthly newsletter reporting current information on research and other institutional activities including projects, conferences and news. It includes the Italian national epidemiological bulletin (BEN, Bollettino Epidemiologico Nazionale).

### Rapporti ISTISAN
